

Your visit will begin in our <u>Library and Learning Commons</u> (yellow "hello!" on aerial photo). The library address is <u>400 Hood College Dr.</u>, <u>Frederick</u>, <u>Maryland</u>, <u>21701</u>. To access reserved admission visitor parking we recommend you enter Hood College on the main drive (Hood Drive). At the stop sign in front of Alumnae Hall, turn right. At the stop sign at Martha Church Drive, turn right. The entrance to access parking will be just past the library on your right (yellow box on aerial photo). Park in a space marked with a yellow "Admission Visitor" sign * and make your way to the <u>Library and Learning Commons</u>. Follow the yellow check-in signs to library entrances and a member of our staff will be at the Information Desk to check you in. If no staff member is present when you arrive please make yourself comfortable in the seating area just behind the desk and we will check you in at the visit start-time.



* If there are no spaces available in the lot next to the library feel free to park in any open space in the parking areas noted with a bright blue box on the aerial photo. Guests can access parking via Martha Church drive if Hood Dr. is closed due to construction.

We're adding campus parking! From mid-May through mid-August several parking lots on campus will be undergoing renovation and expansion. The red lines of the aerial photo indicate fenced-off areas of our campus.

- We may be unable to provide a campus tour for guests who arrive 15 minutes or later than their scheduled visit start-time.
- Campus tours include a residence hall and unoccupied show room. However, please note that this room may be unavailable without prior notice. Information on all of our residence halls can be viewed here.
- Nursing facility tours are available for students who will apply, have applied or have been accepted to Hood's nursing program. Touring the facility will add 30 minutes to your visit.
- Weather in our area can be unpredictable, and campus tours happen rain or shine! In the summer and early
 fall, expect it to be hot and humid with possible thunderstorms. We recommend you bring water, sunscreen
 and an umbrella or raincoat. For inclement weather in the winter, please call 301-696-3400 before you travel
