We look forward to seeing you on Hood College's campus for your upcoming visit. Your visit will begin in our Library and Learning Commons (#29 on this map). The library address is 400 Hood College Dr., Frederick, Maryland, 21701.

PARKING: To access reserved admission visitor parking we recommend you enter Hood College Hood College Drive. At the stop sign in front of Alumnae Hall, turn right onto Brodbeck Drive. At the stop sign turn right onto Martha Church Drive. Reserved parking is next to the library on your right. Spaces are reserved for you with a yellow "Admission Visitor" sign and cone. Please move the cone to the front of the spot when parking.

CHECK-IN: After parking, follow the yellow "Admission Visitor" check-in signs to library entrances and a member of our staff will be at the Information Desk to check you in. If no staff member is present when you arrive please make yourself comfortable in the seating area just behind the desk and we will check you in at the visit start-time.

PLEASE NOTE:

If your visit includes a group information session and you would also like to meet individually with an admission counselor this can be requested during your visit. We will happily arrange a meeting for you which will take place after your campus tour.

Nursing facility tours are available for students who will apply, have applied or have been accepted to Hood's nursing program. Touring the facility will add 30 minutes to your visit.

We may be unable to provide a campus tour for guests who arrive 15 minutes or later than their scheduled visit start-time.
