

## M.S. in Management Information Systems Program Planning Guide

## NOTES

- 1. Program requirements to completion: 30 credits beyond the Foundation courses. Foundation courses are not eligible to be used as elective courses. All degree requirements must be met within seven (7) years of enrolling in the first course applied towards the program. International students may be required to complete *EAP 500 English for Academic Purposes*.
- 2. It is the student's responsibility to: (a) know and follow the program requirements and fulfill them, (b) plan their semester course schedules to remain compliant with external requirements (e.g. visa, scholarship) using the offering schedule below, even though these are projections and subject to adjustment, and (c) request written approval for any course substitutions from your academic adviser or program director prior to enrollment. Failure to receive approval for course substitutions prior to enrollment may result in a delay in program completion.
- Students without background in Management may have to take the two MGMT Foundation courses. MGMT 550 Business Analytics can be waived if students have completed Calculus I and Statistics. Students without background in Information Technology may have to take IT 510 and CSIT 512 depending on academic or professional experience.
- 4. If a student takes MGMT 564, then MGMT 568 becomes available as an elective and viceversa.
