The law and criminal justice major is unique and distinctive, offering two concentrations with separate objectives and goals. The law concentration will give you a rigorous curriculum preparing you for law school and careers in the legal profession such as prosecutors, defense attorneys and judges. The criminal justice concentration provides you with a challenging curriculum focusing on criminal behavior and the operation of the criminal justice system.

Our faculty are committed teachers, active in scholarship, service and mentorship; faculty who will work with you and help you develop critical thinking skills. You'll integrate the concepts from a broad curriculum to solve real-world problems.

As an undergraduate student, you'll have access to our moot courtroom, where you will use this interactive classroom for criminal trials and for appellate legal proceedings. Each year, the 400-level Civil Liberties class participates in a semester-long hypothetical Supreme Court case and then presents the case for oral argument.
