Quick Guide to Advising and Registration Summer/Fall 2023

- Watch for communication from your advisor on signing up and preparing for an advising session during the two-week advising period Monday, April 3 – Friday, April 14. You and your advisor can determine the best way to meet, such as in-person vs Zoom, or other.
 Your advisor is listed in Self-service on your course schedule.
- 2. If you're ready to declare, complete a <u>Declaration of Major/Minor/Certificate Form.</u>
- 3. Review your transcript and Degree Progress report (DPR) in Self-service, and the <u>Catalog</u> for specific core and program requirements.
- 4. Check for any holds preventing registration in Self-Service; hover over the Registration tab and click Courses. If you have a hold you will see a red banner with a message "Account is on Stop list" along with a description.
- 5. Courses may only be taken at other institutions with <u>prior approval</u>, if not offered at Hood during that semester/session. View approved transfer course equivalencies in Self-Service by clicking the Planning tab, Hood Transfer Equivalencies.
- 6. Undergraduate degrees require a minimum of **124** credit hours, completion of core and major requirements, and minimum 2.0 cumulative and major GPAs. Your major gpa is listed on your DPR. (Certain majors may have higher cumulative/major gpa requirements). The final 30 credit hours must be completed at Hood.
- 7. Prepare a list of tentative courses and save to your cart in Self-service for review with your advisor. Be sure to check your cart for common registration errors such as time/date conflicts, prerequisites, etc. In Self-Service, hover over the Reports tab and click "Check My Cart".
- 8. Should you need instructor signature to waive a pre-requisite, register for departmental honors/independent study, or are unable to register in Self-service, complete a Registration & Drop/Add Form and submit to Registrar's office (2nd floor Apple Resource Center), or email registrar@hood.edu.
- 9. Come to advising prepared with questions, and be open to discussing recent challenges, alerts, or low midterm grades! Your advisor will authorize you to register.
- 10. Register in self-service for summer (if desired) and fall 2023 on the date according to your <u>current</u> class standing. View the Student User Guide registration overview in Self-service under Quick Links.
