


## Chromebooks: Connecting to the unsecure@hood wireless network

Chromebooks will automatically connect to Hood's "unsecure@hood" wireless network, but you will need to login in order to use this connection. Please follow the simple instructions below to allow your Chromebook to connect to [unsecure@hood.edu](mailto:unsecure@hood.edu).

NOTE: You only need to provide the information below. You do not have to enter any other information.

- Choose unsecure@hood for your wireless connection
- Click "connect"
- Open a web browser of your choice. You will automatically see the web page below.
- Enter your Hood user ID and Password
- Click "Log In"
