Mission

The Office and Institutional Research and Assessment (OIRA) provides and coordinates institutional research that helps inform the planning, decision-making, budgeting, compliance, assessment and accreditation processes that allow Hood College to fulfill its mission and strategic priorities.

Goal 1

Provide institutional and academic data to academic departments in support of the program review process. (*Process Oriented Goal*)

Objective

- 1.1 Use updated (2018) Program Review requirements and feedback from departments to build a standard data set to meet needs of the report.
- 1.2 Provide institutional and academic data to the departments for the first set of programs for the annual review

Outcome

1.1 OIRA will design a data set to clearly communicate data per Program Review writing prompts. (Operational Outcome)

OIRA will work with Provost to identify data needed and structure data file to meet academic department and program needs.

Performance Criteria – Met / In Progress / Not Met

1.2 Academic Departments under review for 2018-19 cycle will receive their department/program final data set. (Operational Outcome)

OIRA will compile data sets over summer 2018 for 5 years (2013-14 through 2017-18) and provide data packet to the Program Directors by August 1
