Outcome	Description
<b>1. Communication</b>	Graduate students will communicate clearly and effectively in oral, written, and/or visual formats, consistent with the standards of their discipline.
<b>2. Research</b>	Graduate students will identify and explore relevant questions and/or problems by accessing, evaluating, applying, and conducting research using discipline-specific strategies.
<b>3. Critical Reasoning</b>	Graduate students will approach content and tasks with a thoughtful, critical awareness, framed by knowledge, skills, and attitudes appropriate to their discipline.
<b>4. Problem Solving</b>	Graduate students will apply advanced disciplinary content knowledge and strategies to understand and address problems and questions relevant to their discipline and to which they have not previously been introduced.
<b>5. Diversity</b>	Graduate students will recognize diverse ideas, perspectives, and traditions that inform their discipline, profession, and graduate experience.
<b>6. Professionalism</b>	Graduate students will engage in legal, ethical, and professional behaviors consistent with their discipline, including leadership, teamwork, and/or other responsibilities to key stakeholders.
