CPT Harrant was born in Frederick, Maryland. He enlisted into the United States Army in 2002 as a Unit Supply Specialist. After being awarded a Green to Gold scholarship, CPT Harrant received his Bachelor of Arts degree in Business Management with a concentration in accounting and commissioned as a Quartermaster Officer from Hood College in 2011. He is currently pursuing his Master's degree in Higher Education Administration at University of Louisville.

After completing the Quartermaster Basic Officer Leadership Course at Fort Lee, Virginia, he was assigned to Golf Company, 1st Battalion 76th Field Artillery, 3rd Infantry Division at Fort Stewart, Georgia. While there, he served as the Distribution Platoon Leader, Maintenance Control Officer and Company Executive Officer. In October 2014, CPT Harrant took over as the 703rd Brigade Support Battalion S4 OIC. He was selected to serve as the 2nd Brigade Logistics Liaison Officer located at United States Army Africa (USARAF) in Vicenza, Italy.

His follow on assignment was the Combined Logistics Captains Career Course at Fort Lee, Virginia. After graduation, CPT Harrant was assigned to Headquarters Support Company, 70th Brigade Support Battalion as the Deputy Support Operations officer.
