## Top Ten Tips for Advising and Registration for summer/fall 2019

- Watch for communication from your advisor on signing up and preparing for an advising session during the advising period Monday, March 25- Friday April 5, 2019. Your advisor is listed in Selfservice, click on class schedule and advisor is listed at the bottom.
- 2. If you are a sophomore (or later) and still undeclared, complete a <u>Declaration of Major/Minor/Certificate Form</u>.
- Review your transcript and Degree Progress report in Self-service. Refer to core and program requirements as needed in the <u>Catalog</u>. Click the upper right corner of the page for an earlier Catalog.
- 4. Check for any holds preventing registration in Self-Service; click the Register tab, then Traditional Courses to see if you have any STOP signs.
- 5. Courses may only be taken at other institutions with <u>prior approval</u>, if not offered at Hood during that semester/session. Access the <u>transfer evaluation</u> tool in Self-service to see approved transfer course equivalencies; <u>ARTSYS</u> can also be used for MD community colleges and schools.
- 6. Undergraduate degrees require at least 124 credit hours, completion of core and major requirements, and minimum 2.0 cumulative and major GPAs. (Certain majors may have higher cumulative/major gpa requirements). The final 30 credit hours must be completed at Hood College.
- 7. Prepare a draft of your fall (and summer, if desired) schedules. While searching for courses in Self-service, it may be useful to create a <u>draft</u>. Save courses to your cart in Self-service for review with your advisor.
- 8. Should you need instructor signature to waive a pre-requisite, register for departmental honors/independent study, or are unable to register in Self-service, complete a Registration & Drop/Add Form and submit to Registrar's office (2nd floor Apple Resource Center).
- 9. **Come to advising prepared** with questions, and be open to discussing recent challenges, alerts, or low midterm grades. Your advisor will clear you to register.
- 10. Register for summer and fall 2019 on the date according to your current class standing:

Non-graduating Seniors (87 or more credits earned): Monday, April 8, 12:01 a.m.

Juniors (56-86 credits earned): Monday, April 8, 12:01 a.m.

Sophomores (25-55 credits earned): Tuesday, April 9, 12:01 a.m.

Freshmen (fewer than 25 credits earned): Monday, April 15, 12:01 a.m.

New undergraduate and non-degree student registration begins Monday, April 15th.
